The Women of Easter – Week 3

'Truly I tell you, wherever the gospel is preached throughout the world what she has done will also be told, in memory of her'. Mark 14:9 (*In Jewish customs memorials were very important. Her service serves as an act of historical remembrance. Here service is forever established as a memorial for Jesus' crucifixion as the Passover Lamb*).

We learn Mary understood what was happening and BELIEVED. Which caused her to act. Belief and action must go together to those who follow Jesus.

While many hoped to catch a glimpse of Jesus, Mary wanted to KNOW him. So many people in our culture want a glimpse of Jesus.
